Our Topic this Term is 'Through the Ages'

In Through the Ages project, your child will learn about three different periods of British prehistory: the Stone Age, the Bronze Age and the Iron Age. They will discover terminology relating to time and sequence dates to make a timeline. They explore the changes to people, homes and lifestyle throughout the different periods and investigate examples of prehistoric settlements, monuments, burials and artefacts in detail. They will also study how technology improved over time, including how the discovery of different metals changed the way that people lived.

English

This half term we will be learning how to write a Non-Chronological Report, we will get the inspiration for our reports our knowledge about The Stone Age. We will then move on to writing a narrative through reading 'The Stone Age Boy' we will learn all about the features of a narrative and practise applying them in our own writing.

How you could help your child prepare for the topic...

It's amazing to think that Stone Age people were alive 2.5 million years ago! As they used to paint on walls, why not create a painting on an old roll of wallpaper or a smooth stone from the garden? Or use the internet to find out about Iron Age hillforts – could you draw your own and label its features?

Our learning for this half term will be:

- Place value
- Ordering and comparing numbers
- Addition
- Subtraction

General Reminders:
