Our Topic this Term is 'Through the Ages'

Our mini projects are: "Animal nutrition and skeletons" "Complement and Contrast," "Our Planet, One World," "Prehistoric pots" and "Cook well Eatwell".

Through our mini projects we will be exploring science, art, geography and design technology. Children will be investigating how the body works and moves and will be researching a focused topic of their choosing. In art, children will be using watercolours to explore the effects of colour ranges on their audience. In geography, we will be looking at our local area, using mapping skills and thinking about land use. Finally, in DT we will be thinking about how to cook safely and will be preparing a range of vegetable and meat foods to taste.

English

This half term we will be learning how to write a persuasive letter. Learning about the features and structures needed to be effective writers. We will be selecting an audience and then focusing on the language and structures needed to make our creations suitable for the task.

How you could help your child prepare for the topic...

In preparation for DT, when cooking at home please look at recipes with your children. Also, ask them to help prepare vegetables and meats, discussing nutritional values and balanced diets.

When walking around our local area, please discuss with your children the different places there are to visit and the reasons for these places in our community.

Our learning for this half term will be:

- Addition
- Subtraction
- Multiplication
- Division
- Fractions
- Time
