Our Topic this Half Term is 'Bright Lights, Big City'

In this project, your child will learn the story of a local landmark. They will learn about the countries that make up the United Kingdom, including their location, capital cities and some of their physical and human features. They will have the opportunity to do map work, using compasses, and positional and directional language to plan routes around London. They will research the cause and impact of the Great Fire of London and look at some famous London landmarks. They will learn about other capital cities around the world, including Kuala Lumpur, and compare how they are similar and different to London.

English

In English, we will be looking at the story 'Katie goes to London' by James Mayhew. We will be using this book to do our own story writing, retelling Katie's adventures. We will also be exploring the famous landmarks in London and writing a set of instructions for a London tour.

How you could help your child prepare for the topic...

Choose a London landmark that interests you and your child. Carry out some research to find 5 fun facts about it.

You could go on a walk around your local area. Practise identifying the physical features (that are naturally there) and the human features (made by people).

Maths

Our learning for this half term will be:

- Counting, reading and writing number patterns
- Addition and subtraction
- Grouping and sharing
- Fractions
- Measure

General Reminders:
