We ensure that all children are able to have uninterrupted time to play and explore and is equipped with resources that the children can move, change and affect.

Each day our Reception children will learn as a whole class, led by their teachers, Mrs McCombe and Mrs Harrison. They will also join in small group learning or be independent in their play. Every day we will have dedicated time for the teaching of Phonics, Reading, Writing and Maths. All learning will be delivered through a wide range of stimulating topics that will engage the children and help them to develop knowledge and skills along with providing them with many opportunities to predict, question and investigate.
