## Our Topic this Half Term is 'Me and My Community' and 'Exploring Autumn'

This half term, we'll be learning about the school community and building friendships. We will be exploring the school grounds and find out about all the people in school who are there to help us. We will exploring how we are special and unique and how everyone's family is different. We will take part in practical activities to support us in building new friendships and explore what makes a good friend. We will also find out about people in the community who help us, including doctors, nurses, and the emergency services. In the Exploring Autumn project, we will go on a woodland walk to learn about the seasonal changes that happen in autumn. We will learn about birds and animals that live in the woods and how they survive as the weather gets colder. We will take part in practical and creative activities that will support us to learn about autumn.

English This half term we will be learning different nursery rhymes and learning about rhyming and rhythm. We will be acting out nursery rhymes and drawing pictures about them. We will also be enjoying stories about friendship, talking about what happens in each part and learning new words from the stories. In Reception, we will be starting phonics. We will be learning about sounds around us and sounds in words. We will start to learn the sounds the letters of the alphabet make. We will use these sounds to help us write the sounds we can hear in words. We will be starting Write Dance and Dough Disco to help strengthen our arms, hands and fingers ready for writing.

How you could help your child prepare for the topic Look at family photographs together and discuss who is part of your family and extended family. Look at baby photographs and talk about how they have grown. Look at any childhood photographs of parents and grandparents. Talk about the things you like to do together and places you like to go. Go on a walk around your local area and talk about what happens to trees and plants during autumn. Take some pictures to share at school. Collect leaves, seeds, nuts and berries to add to an autumn collection.
