## Our Topic this Half Term is 'Dynamic Dynasties'

Welcome back, this half term year 5 will be continuing with the topic Dynamic Dynasties but will now start to study mini topics in; Science, Geography, Design Technology and Art. We will initially focus on Earth and Space, our learning will progress into Forces and Mechanisms and then into geography where we will be investigating the world.

**In English**, we will be writing non-chronological reports about Space as well as a setting description and finally a persuasive letter concerning the environment.

We will continue to practise the Y5/6 spelling lists; the spellings will be set via Sumdog each week. If you could work with your child on these, we would really appreciate your support. The texts we will be reading will include: Space – DK encyclopaedia and The sea of tranquillity by Mark Haddon.

# How you could help your child prepare for the topic...

We will begin the topic by sharing a letter from Tim Peake and the Space Centre. To explore our new topic further, you could use the internet to conduct some research or visit the library to discover more information about Space.

#### General Reminders:

**PE:** P.E is on a Wednesday and Friday. Please make sure earrings are taken out for these sessions. Children must wear the correct P.E kit (white top / black bottoms).

**I-Pads:** Your child must bring their school i-pad each day and ensure it has been charged at home.

every day for break, fruit or vegetables.

#### **Maths**

The topics this half term are:

- using multiplication and division skills,
- fractions and decimals.
- 2D and 3D shape
- bar charts and tables.

You can help your child by practising times tables, (using TT Rockstars). Also practise division facts, e.g.  $81 \div 9 = 9$  therefore 9x9=81. Please encourage your child to use Sumdog to reinforce their learning too.
