In this project, your child will learn all about Coastlines. They will explore what human and physical features coastal towns have and what landmarks make a coastal town special. The children will be exploring Whitby, the RNLI and learning about a famous person called Captain Cook. There will also be an exciting opportunity to create some art in the style of waves, as well as creating posters for the RNLI. The children will also be given opportunities to talk about their own experiences of a coastal town.

Somebody Swallowed Stanley by Sarah Roberts.We will also be using lots of books like Tale of Whale and the Big Book of the Blue.The genres we will be learning to write are narratives and letters to inform. It would also be great to practice recalling the three times tables.
