Our Topic this Term is 'Rocks, Relics and Rumbles'

This project teaches children about the features and characteristics of Earth's layers, including a detailed exploration of volcanic, tectonic and seismic activity. Children will explore the importance of Mary Anning and her discoveries, look at a range of fossils, including the process of how they are made, and will explore the Ring of Fire. Towards the end of the topic, the children will be part of a team of scientists, geologists and volcanologists sent to investigate the potential dangers of tectonic activity, taking part in their own volcanic explosions.

English

This half term we will be learning how to write a biography, using the biography of David Attenborough as a model. Children will look at what features are needed, including fronted adverbials, reported speech, chronological order and topic vocabulary, before writing their own biographies about Mary Anning. Children will then explore writing a diary entry, again looking at specific features before writing their own, based on the text Escape from Pompeii.

How you could help your child prepare for the topic...

Rocks, Relics and Rumbles is a topic that children enjoy each year. Can you make an information poster about Mary Anning, the famous fossil collector, including images and interesting facts?

If you want to be creative, investigate and create a 3D model of the layers of the Earth using a range of materials.

Maths

Our learning for this half term will be:

- Place value
- Rounding
- Addition and subtraction by partitioning
- Multiplication and division
- Right angles within shapes

General Reminders:

Home Learning: Your child will be able to access home learning activities through Purple Mash. Children will also receive a homework booklet. This will include activities linked to Maths and English.
