Our Topic this Term is 'Rocks, Relics and Rumbles' Our mini projects are: 'Ammonite' 'Making it move' 'Forces and magnets' and 'People and places'.

Through our mini projects we will exploring, Art and Design, Science and Design and Technology. Children will be practising with different drawing techniques and clay sculpture in Art. They will also be learning all about L.S. Lowry and creating the different techniques and styles he used through his artwork. In Design and Technology the children will be investigating how a range mechanisms help objects move, focusing on linkages, levers, sliders and wheels. Finally in Science we will be experimenting with forces and magnets, learning about frictional and contact forces and studying magnetic attraction.

English: This half term we will be learning how to write a narrative, we will learn about the features of a story and apply them into our own writing. We will using the knowledge we gained from creating a newspaper report last half term all about the eruption of Mount Vesuvius and the impact on people who in lived in Pompeii.
