Our Topic this Half Term is 'School Days'

In the 'School Days' project, your child will learn about the differences between schooling in the Victorian era and schooling today. They will learn about objects found in a Victorian classroom and how they were used. They will research Samuel Wilderspin, an important figure in the development of schooling for young children in the Victorian era, whose ideals are reflected in schooling today. They will learn to describe the passage of time through study of past, present and future tense vocabulary.

English

This half term we will be learning how to write instructions for how to grow a fictional plant e.g. a money plant or a snowflake plan. The children will use time words (First, Next, Then), to order their instructions and they will use describing words (adjectives) and the conjunction 'and' to stretch their sentences and make them exciting to read.

Your child will also be writing a story about their 'ideal school'. They will draw upon their knowledge of what a Victorian school was like compared with what schools are like today.

How you could help your child prepare for the topic...

To help your child understand the passing of time, you could ask your children to use these time phrases in sentences; today, yesterday, next week, in the future, last year.

You could do some research; here are some good sites/videos to use: CBBC – The students get a Victorian schooling and BBC Bitesize – Who was Queen Victoria?

Maths

Our learning for this half term will be:

- Number and place value
- Addition and subtraction
- Multiplication and division
- Fractions
- Measure
- Position and direction

General Reminders:
