

Home Learning At Reigate Park

We have made some changes to how we will be delivering home learning which we would like to share with you. From Monday 25th January we will be using a timetable to structure the day for you and the children with approximate times for each learning task.

We will continue to use Purple Mashoffer your child learning which they can complete at home. We are using Purple Mash as a way to send home the tasks and also as a way for the children and teachers to be able to communicate easily with each other.

If your child is self-isolating and well enough to learn OR If your child is in a bubble which has been closed, but is well enough to learn at home	 Access the Friday Purple Mash Email and access the weekly timetable Access the daily Purple Mash Email and complete all activities. Send all completed learning back to the class teacher for feedback.
For those children who are in school	• Continue to practise reading, completing TT Rockstars etc as before. The children are welcome to complete the 2Dos set via Purple Mash.

HOW IT WILL WORK:

- Every Friday the class teacher will send an email out to the child through Purple Mash with a timetable of learning for the following week.
- The following week class teachers will send a daily email between 8.30 and 8.45 with learning activities/links to 2Dos etc for that day in line with the weekly timetable.
- If the children have any questions then they can email back to ask.
- Work which has been set through 2Dos may receive feedback.
- Work which has been completed in the Home Learning Book can be photographed, uploaded and emailed back to the teacher for feedback.
- Every child has been provided with a Home Learning workbook to complete the work which is not set through 2Dos.
